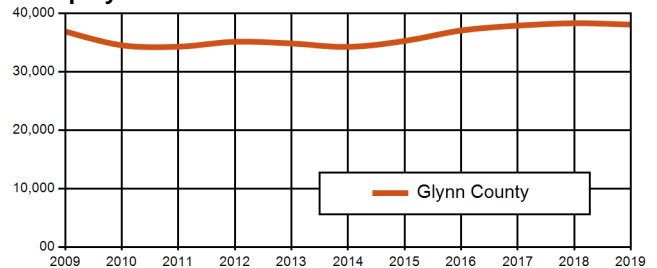

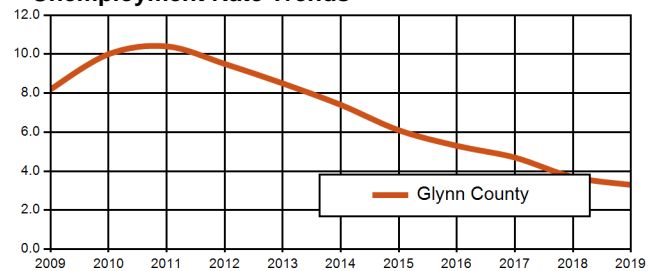

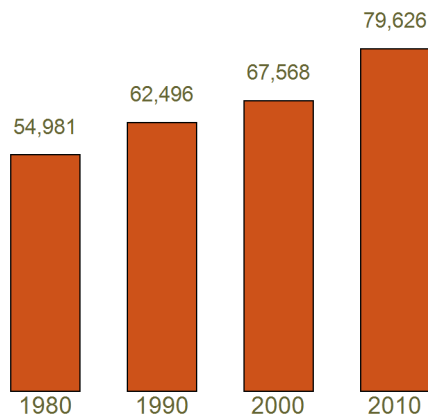

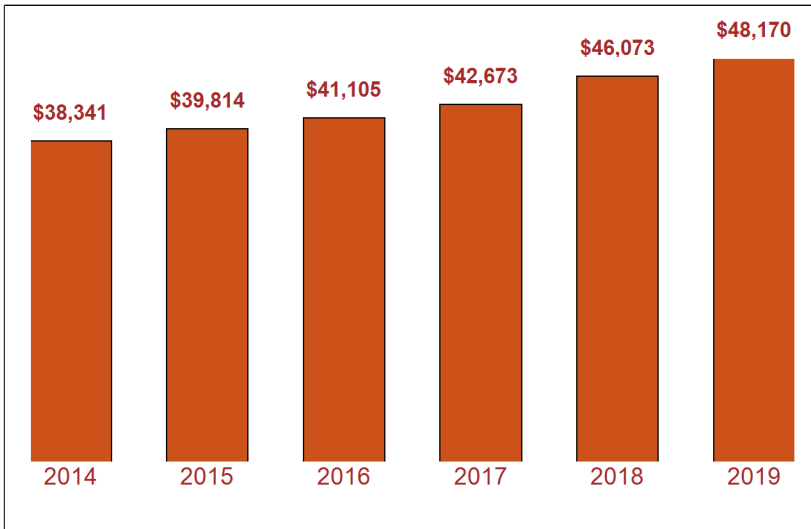

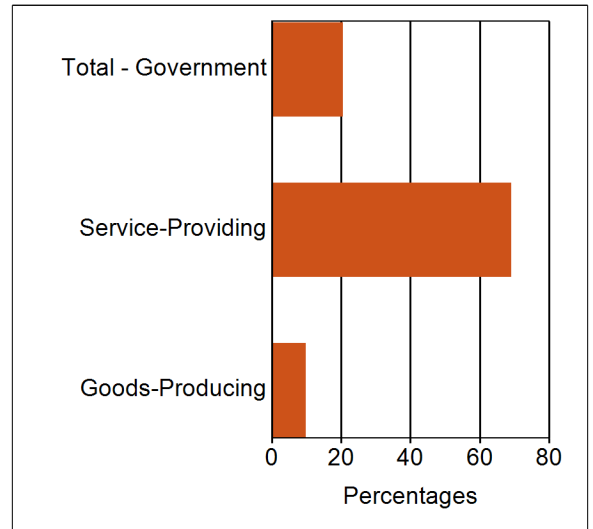
Glynn Per Capita Income
