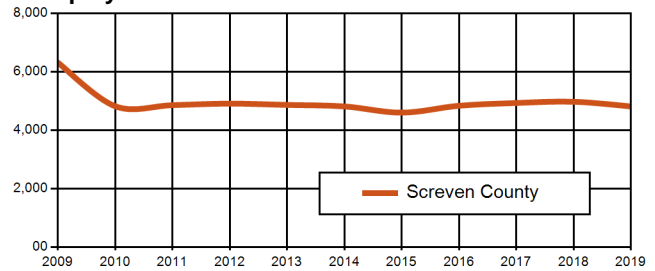

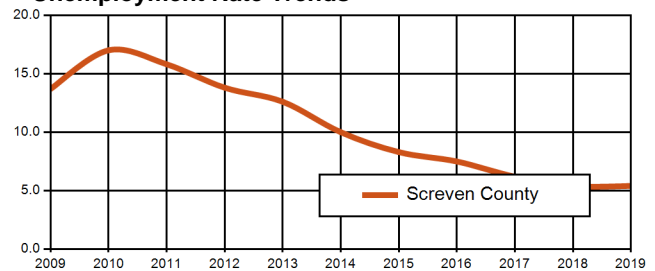

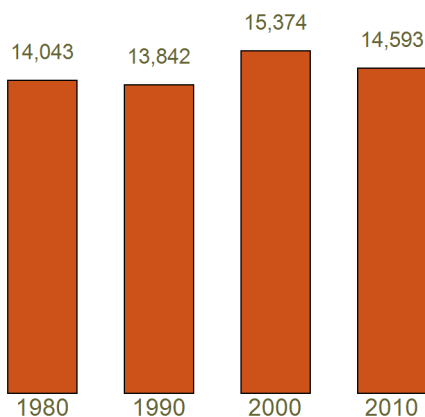
Employment Trends

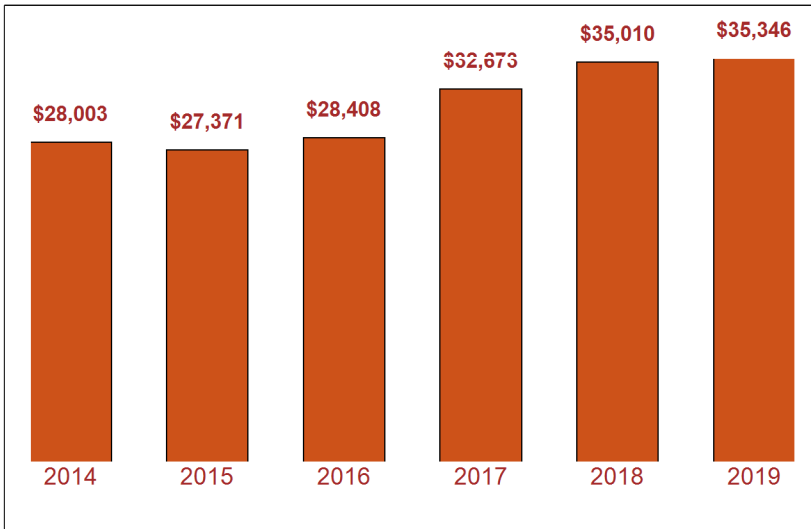

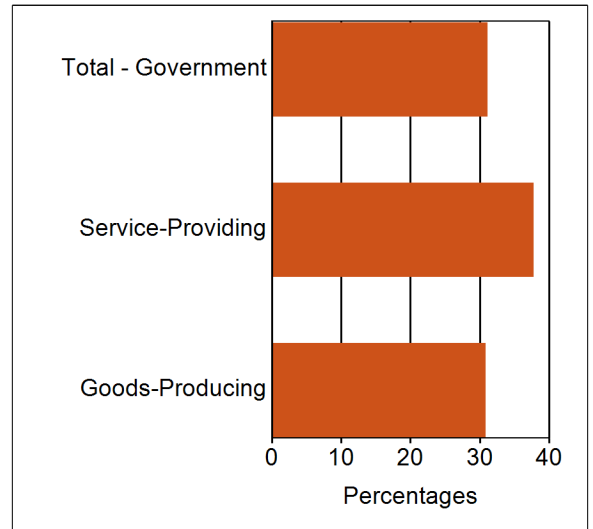
