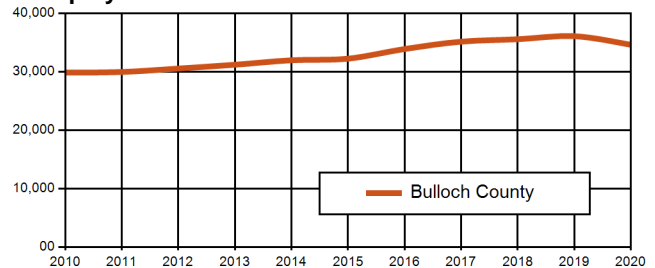

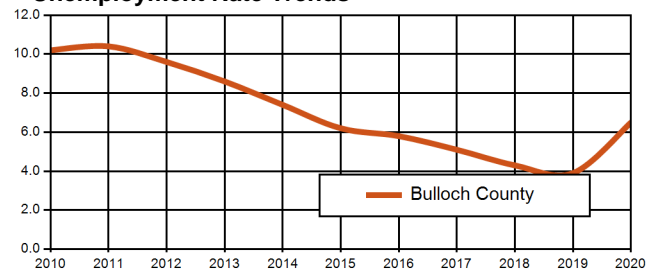

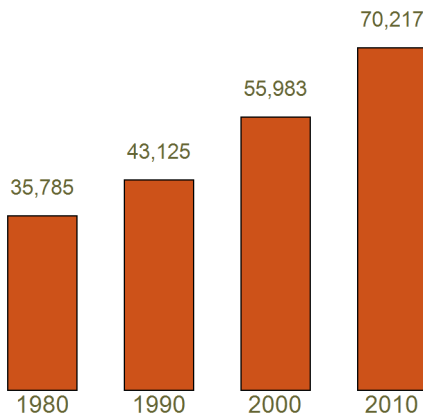
Employment Trends

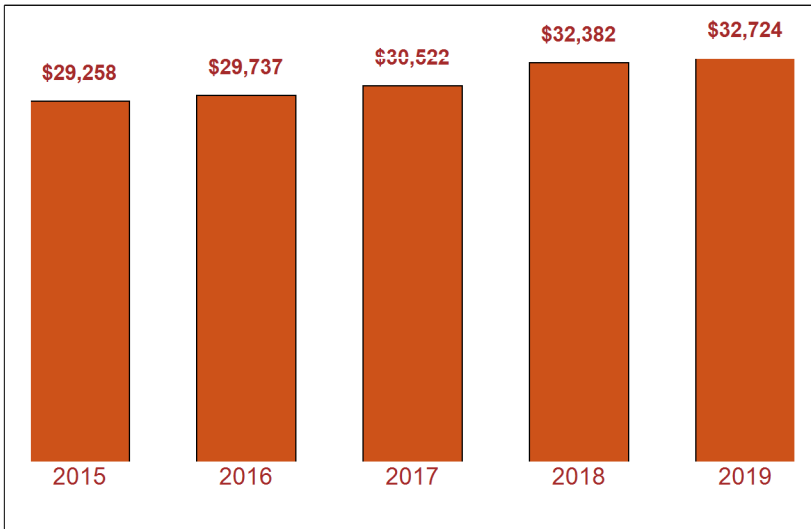

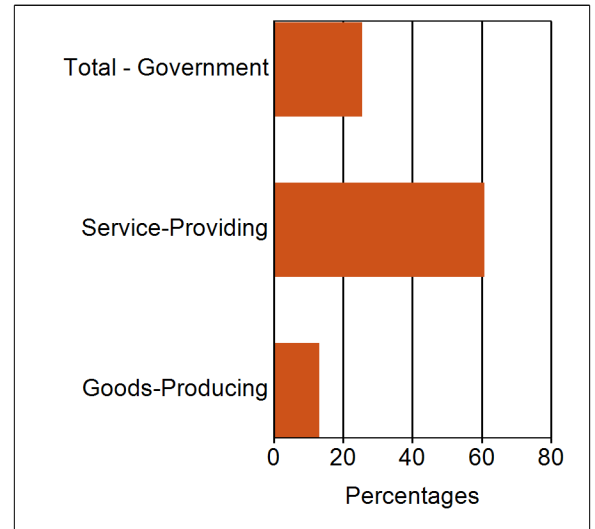
Bulloch Per Capita Income
