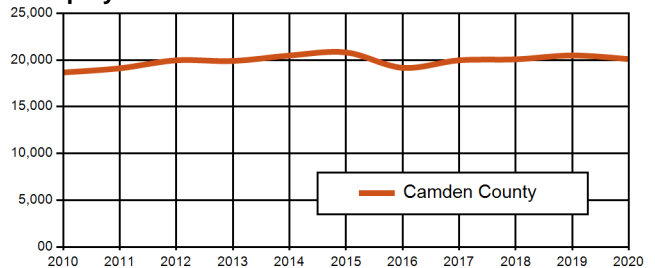

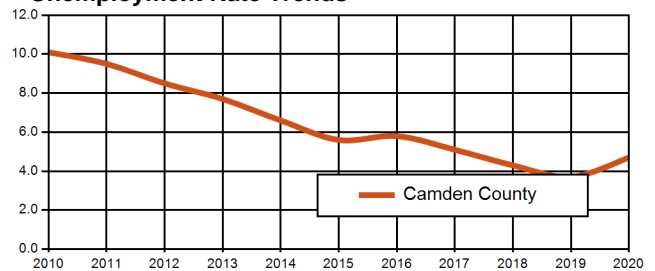

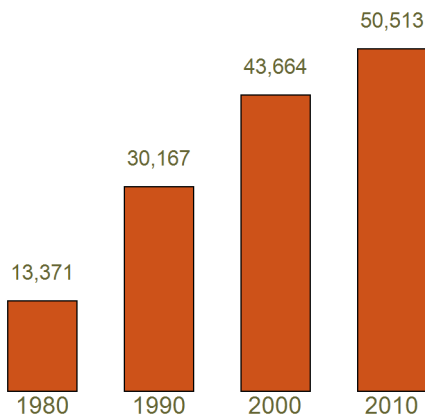

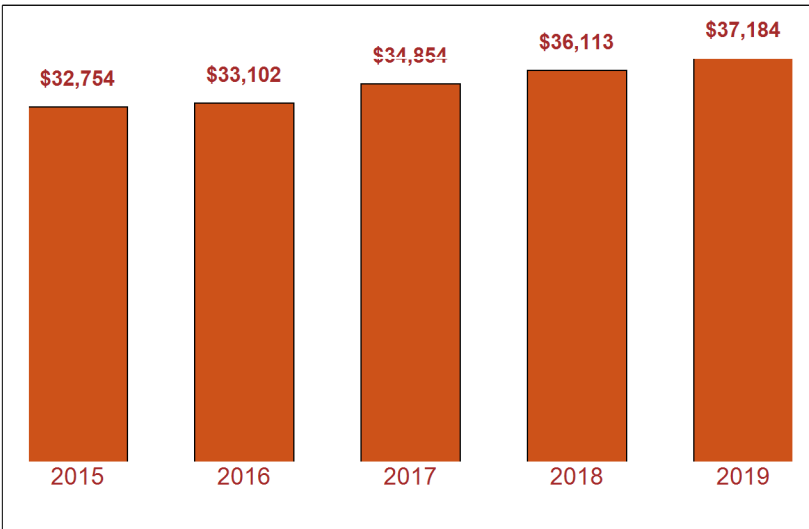

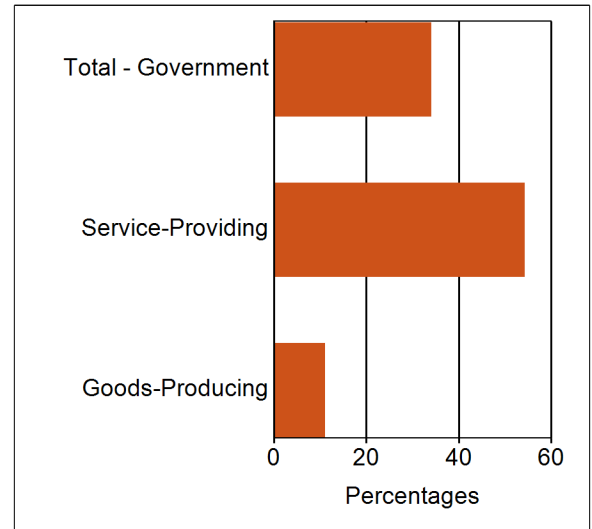
Camden Per Capita Income
